





SWIMMING POOL

Rules & Regulations

Please take out your Rules & Regulations and review the last two pages which reflect the guidelines for Swimming Pool use and safety. You may be surprised to find many points that you have forgotten. Here are a few:

- ✓ No person under the age of 18 is permitted in the pool (except as noted for grandchildren's hours, which are <u>Tuesdays</u>, <u>Thursdays</u> and <u>Saturdays</u> between Noon and 3:00 pm).
- Glass containers, food and beverages are not allowed in the pool area.
   In addition, smoking is prohibited.
- Though the above are State regulations, our Board does allow plastic water bottles. We also have special allowances during resident parties.
- Residents and guests must sign in and out of the pool area and must show their proximity card or GUEST BADGE upon request by a staff member or resident.
